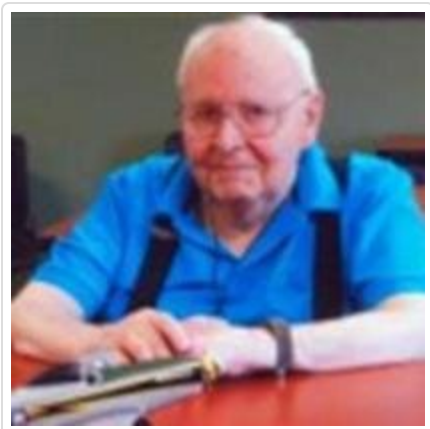




Harry L. Crooks
