FLORAL REMINDERS

Daily Cemetery Hours are 8 AM to 8 PM

Fresh cut flowers placed in the bronze vase of a memorial marker are allowed any time. When fresh cut flowers have wilted, the cemetery grounds crew will remove and dispose of them and turn the vase down into the marker. *(If you do not have a permanent vase for your flowers, you may purchase one in the cemetery office. Temporary cones are available at the front entrance of the cemetery)*

Artificial flowers, wreaths, plastic decoration, etc. are permitted in the cemetery ONLY from November 15th through March 15th (grass growing season) as they contain wire and other materials potentially injurious to mowing equipment, grounds crew, and markers. The cemetery maintenance crew will immediately remove any artificial decorations found during the grass growing season.

Flags as part of a floral bouquet placed in the bronze vase are allowed. When the flowers have wilted, the cemetery staff will remove and dispose of the flowers and flag.

On Memorial Day you are welcome to place floral displays, including cut flowers, potted plants, wreaths and flags. These will be kept on the graves beginning Memorial Day weekend for one full week and then removed by the grounds staff.

Potted Plants are permitted ONLY for the following occasions: Easter, Memorial Day, Mother's Day, and Father's Day. Placement is allowed during the week of the occasion, and **they will be removed the week following the occasion.**

Disposition of unauthorized decorations

We urge all families NOT to bring items of monetary value or sentimental family treasures to the graveside. Shepherd hooks, wind chimes, plastic decorations, solar lights, balloons, and birdhouses are not permitted at any time. Please note all unauthorized decorations will be removed and disposed of immediately.

THE CEMETERY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOSS OR THEFT OF ANY FLORAL DISPLAYS, VASES OR OTHER ITEMS ON OR NEAR BURIAL SITES.
