FLOWER RULES AND REGULATIONS

In order to preserve and perpetuate the recognized natural beauty of Hillside Cemetery for the living as well as our beloved dead we ask the cooperation of all lot owners and all others whose interests are here to observe the following regulations which were adopted by the Board of Directors of Hillside Cemetery.

Fresh cut flowers are permitted in places of interment throughout the grass-growing season from March 1st to November 1st. No glass jars, coffee cans, etc., please.

We encourage the free use of our metal cone-shaped cut flower containers available in front of the office any time the gates are open. Limit 2 per grave, please.

Mausoleum crypt and niche flowers must be placed in a bronze vase or flower cone. No flowers or decorations will be allowed on the crypt or niche fronts.

Potted plants are permitted ONLY for Decoration Day, Easter, Mother's Day, and Father's Day. Placement may be made during the week before and will be removed the 7th day following the occasion.

Evergreen wreaths may be placed from November 1st to March 1st. Any item to be saved must be picked up by owners before Spring Clean-Up which may begin, weather permitting, after March 1st.

Artificial flowers, wreaths, plastic decorations, etc. are not permitted in the cemetery from March 1st thru November 1st. Most of these contain wire and other materials potentially injurious to mowing equipment and operators, and do deteriorate from weather, wind and sun. The cemetery maintenance crew will immediately remove any artificial decorations found during this time period.

Balloons, birdhouses, shepherd hooks, or windchimes are not permitted at any time. The cemetery maintenance crew will immediately remove these items.

Flower crocks, stands & urns must be approved by the cemetery. Hillside will charge an annual assessment fee for all crocks, stands or urns on the cemetery grounds.

ANY CROCKS, STANDS OR URNS INSTALLED WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL WILL BE REMOVED. CROCKS AND STANDS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE MEMORIAL PARK SECTIONS.

PERPETUAL GENERAL CARE

This relates to mowing and reseeding of grass, planting and care of flower beds, shrubs, hedges, maintenance of buildings, fences, gates, roads and the plowing of snow all at no extra cost to lot owners. A substantial Perpetual Care Fund which grows with each new lot sale guarantees that Hillside Cemetery will remain sacred and beautiful for all time.

Perpetual Care does not contemplate or include special services such as: watering of individual lots or flowers, care or trimming around privately owned iron vases, crocks, stands, markers, monuments, all of which have been placed at owner's risk.

VISITOR RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any person found in the grounds after specified gate closing hours will be considered a trespasser.
2. Joy riding or driver training in the cemetery is prohibited.
3. Do not drive or park on the grass. Drive carefully- speed limit 20 mph.
4. All dogs must remain in vehicles. No walking or running of dogs.
Exception:
 - (a) see eye dog
 - (b) cemetery guard dog
5. No motor bikes or bicycles except for attending a funeral or grave visitation.
6. Do not remove or pick any plant, flower, shrub or any decoration that does not belong to you.
7. Loitering, loafing, picnicking, loud or boisterous talking or drinking beer or alcoholic beverages in the cemetery is prohibited. This can be very disturbing to any visitor who has recently lost a loved one.
8. Digging holes for potted plants is expressly prohibited.

HILLSIDE CEMETERY CAN NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE, LOSS, OR THEFT OF ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY SUCH AS FLOWERS, PLANTS, DECORATIONS, VASES, CROCKS, MARKERS MONUMENTS, ETC. REASONABLE PRECAUTIONS AGAINST SUCH LOSS ARE TAKEN BY THE CEMETERY.

SCATTERING OF CREMATED REMAINS

The scattering of cremated remains is not permitted on the grounds of Hillside Cemetery.
