Beloved mother, wife, lifelong Northsider, award winning gardener, artist, baker and powerful voice for social justice passed away suddenly on Friday June 18, 2021 joining her beloved husband of 27 years, Bob. Audrie was born, raised and made her home in North Minneapolis where she attended St. Bridget's Catholic School and Saint Margaret's Academy. The sixth of eight children, she was the quiet one but later developed into a rather outspoken, spirited and witty woman. She never missed a chance to share her opinion which usually centered on 'doing the right thing'. She was a master of resistance and lived her values of fighting injustice everywhere she found it. She tended a garden of innumerable perennial plants, and was known for her heirloom tomatoes which she canned and shared generously. She is revered for her homemade baked goods, her pièce de resistance- a perfected family recipe for chocolate buttercream frosting. Only weeks ago she finally revealed the crucial step to achieve frosting perfection (cook only the unsweetened chocolate, sugar and cream, then beat together with frozen butter-you're welcome). Audrie only used quality butter and chocolate for her baking-and you should too. She is preceded in death by Bob, the fierce love of her life, beloved dogs (who each held human status), Peaches, Chloe, Lady who were Chesapeake Bay Retrievers, a smart and sensitive breed, and Mr. T, a loving boxer, one grand-dog Payback the American bull dog with a ferocious heart, her dear sisters Mary Edwards and Barbara McGuire, and her parents Audrie and Robert Anderson. She is survived by her three children Nellie (Reid), Louis and little Audie, her dearest friend Judy and many other kindred spirits, neighbors, friends, coworkers, and siblings: brother, Ted (Nancy) Anderson; sisters Roberta (Richard) Pinc, Nancy Schreder, Cat Stone (Scott), Julie Patterson, many brother and sister in laws from the Munn family, and dozens of nieces and nephews on both sides who she loved in her own way. A memorial celebration of Audrie's life will be held on Saturday July 10, 2021 at 12 noon at Lakewood Memorial Chapel 3600 Hennepin Avenue S. Minneapolis, followed by a picnic at Beard's Plaisance, Lake Harriet.
