Her interest in sports continued into adulthood as she became an avid fan of the Denver Broncos. Michelle also enjoyed being on the Colorado State University (CSU) campus where she worked for 23 years.

Through divine intervention, Michelle was able to travel across the country and join her sister in Minnesota in 2015. It was then that she became a MN Vikings fan. She moved to the Shady View Group Home in Plymouth and brought joy and laughter to everyone she met. Her life was enriched by attending many country music concerts, enjoying Minnesota Twins games, going to the Minnesota State Fair, movies and family holiday celebrations. Michelle also celebrated the birth of her only great niece, visited the cabin, and just last summer hosted an extended Arnold family reunion.

Michelle spent her last twenty-four days at St. Francis Hospital in Shakopee where she and her family received tender and compassionate care from nurses, doctors, wound care specialists, respiratory therapists, environmental services, aides and many others.
