Adamma was born on August 2nd 1950 in Agbaghara Nsu Mbandu, Imo, Nigeria to Marcella and Semion Osuji. She graduated from the College of Education (Uyo, Nigeria) in 1977 with a degree in Education, She also holds a Bachelors of Science (1983) and 2 Masters of Education (1991, 1998) from the University of Minnesota, as well as a Doctor of Education (2002) from the University of St. Thomas. She married Conleth Chukwudi Anya, in Nigeria on Feb, 28th 1984 and in the US on Oct 9th, 2001. After moving to the United

States, Adamma attended various colleges and universities. In 1989 she began working for the Minneapolis Public School district and welcomed her daughter Uchenna on January 14th, 1985. Adamma taught her many skills including knitting, sewing, and singing. Her thirst for knowledge and determination was also passed down and it will be the most cherished and remembered skill learned. Uchenna remembers her as a driven mother who encouraged everyone to pursue their goals. Adamma received her citizenship to the United States in 1995. She worked as a teacher until she retired in 2005.

Adamma was driven by her desire to help others. She worked for several years for the Minneapolis school district working specifically with special education children. She also had a vibrant social life and was active in the Nigerian community in Minnesota for several years, she was one of the founding members of Igbo fest which is still celebrated in Minnesota annually today. In addition to her education, she received her practical nursing certificate from Minneapolis Technical College in 1992 and joined the Rho Chapter of Omicron Tau Theta a national organization founded in 1922 that is committed to nursing excellence through service, research, leadership, scholarship, knowledge, and professional development all centered on improving world health. She was passionate about changing the world thru education and care.

In 2019 Adamma was diagnosed with breast cancer. She fought hard through 2 rounds of radiation therapy, but finally succumbed to the illness in 2022.
