



## Ms. Agatha Dueck

March 11, 1931 - May 4, 2021

Born March 11, 1931. Mrs. Dueck passed away on Tuesday, May 4, 2021 at the age of 90. She is survived by her children, Pauline Amundson of Grasston, MN; Charlene Hurst of Tampa, FL; Tim Dueck of Robbinsdale, MN and Cynthia Peterson of Fort Myers, FL; 32 grandchildren and 46 great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, Abraham Dueck, who passed away in January 2007 and eldest daughter, Anita Dizney of Federal Way, WA who passed away in February 2021. Abe and Agatha were married in 1950 in Winnipeg, Manitoba Canada, and moved to the Minneapolis area in 1960 where Abe worked as an electrician. Agatha worked as a secretary and food service supervisor when her kids were older, and served in Christian ministry for Women's Aglow for over 20 years. In 1977, Abe and Agatha sold their house in Minneapolis and bought a campground in northern Minnesota which they named Rhema Fellowship, a Christian retreat and recovery center they operated until 1988 when they moved to Two Harbors. They retired in 1996 and lived in Two Harbors until 1998 when they moved back to Minneapolis to live with their son, Tim. Agatha has resided at Hope's Residence in Minneapolis since November 2019 where she received excellent care. Funeral service to be held Sunday, May 9th at 11AM at Washburn-McReavy Glen Haven Chapel.
