



## Alan Paul Stewart

Alan Paul Stewart, 69, of Minnetonka, Minnesota, passed away on January 22, 2026, surrounded by family. He was born on July 12, 1956, in South Shields Tyne & Wear, England, to Fernande (Ann) Telford and Don Stewart. He was a devoted, adoring husband to Carol, loving father to Lynsey and Ian, dear father-in-law to Allie, joyful Papa to Camilla, Faye, and Henry, and beloved brother of Tom.

Alan loved Jesus with a deep, ever-growing, abiding love. Alan loved his family, his church family, and being an Executive Chef, as well as watching his beloved Sunderland futbol team from South Shields, England. His other favorites to watch were the Minnesota Vikings and Winnipeg Jets.

His love for God deepened at a Promise Keepers event in 1995 at the Metrodome. Alan fondly remembers 65,000 men worshipping God in our stadium and singing worship songs. Alan gave his life to Jesus at this event and it was life-changing. He became an even better man. He expanded his penchant for godliness, kindness, and gentleness when he accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior. He proudly lived the life of a Promise Keeper from that day forward for the rest of his life.

His career as a Certified Executive Chef involved many culinary competitions in which he won a considerable number of medals and awards. He spent a career creating dishes at Oak Ridge Country Club, Decathlon Athletic Club, and Interlachen Country Club. While at Interlachen Country Club, he was the Executive Chef of the 2002 Solheim Cup and 2008 U.S. Women's Open. He spent the end of his career at Hyvee before retiring, but he continued to create food for friends and family. He found much joy in the process of creating a dish and presenting it artfully.

Alan enjoyed spending time at the family cabin in Babbitt, Minnesota. His grandkids will fondly remember the holidays, bonfires, and warm summer weekends spent together up north with their Papa. They were the light of his life! He had such patience with each one of them. He would lovingly tease them and validate them. He'd make up special stories and make sure they were paying attention. He doted on each child and always made them feel special.

Alan was a man of courage and integrity. His long battle with multiple autoimmune diseases did not defeat him. He spent countless days in hospitals tied to machines. His positive attitude and indomitable spirit was an inspiration to so many, including the doctors that treated him. He took time to learn about the people who came into his life and helped and mentored many of them. Former employees stayed in touch with him over the years and still called him Chef, a mark of total respect.

A funeral service will be held on Saturday, January 31, 2026, at Faith Church, 12007 Excelsior Boulevard, Minnetonka, MN. The visitation begins at 10:00
