Alice Sofia Larson Johnson League was born March 19, 1918 in Lowell, Mass. The oldest child to Hjalmer and Esther (Hendrickson) Larson. When Alice was an infant her parents moved to Dairyland, Wisconsin where she grew up. She married Charles Johnson and lived in St. Paul, MN living near in the Midway Area around the Minnesota State Fair Grounds. They attended the Midway Tabernacle then, later known as the Apostolic Bible Church. Charles was a contractor, a builder of "modern homes" . To Alice and Charles a daughter was born, Barbara. Barbara passed away in 1959 due to Hepatitis, which was a huge tragedy to Alice. Charles Johnson passed away in 1973, several years later she married Omar League, who died several years ago. In their retirement, Alice and Omar moved to the Eagle Rock, Missouri and later moved to Louisiana, to be near her sister, Lily and husband Edgar Farris. Alice died, May 26, 2008 at the Regency House Care Facility in Alexandria, Louisiana.
