It is with great sadness that the family of Alice Paulson announces her passing after a courageous battle with Alzheimer's disease, on Saturday, January 13th, 2018, at the age of 89 years. She also taught at the Royal Hawaiian School in Honolulu before eventually making her way back to Roseville schools where she served in a variety of teaching roles at North Heights, Central Park, and Brimhall Elementary Schools. She retired from teaching in 1997. In addition to her teaching career, Alice was very active at Bethany Baptist Church in Roseville where she served on just about every committee there ever was. She was also an avid painter and talented piano player. A Memorial Service in memory of Alice will be held on Thursday, January 25th at 11:00 AM (visitation 10 -11 AM) at BETHANY BAPTIST CHURCH; 2025 Skillman Avenue, Roseville, MN.
