



## Alice Hazel Seline

April 5, 1922 - April 9, 2019

Alice Hazel Seline was born Alice Hazel Olson to Olof and Hilma Olson on April 5, 1922 in Rutland, North Dakota. She grew up on the family farm east of Rutland and graduated from Rutland High School in 1939. In the early 1940s she attended Bethel College in St. Paul, Minnesota where she studied Christian education. She then worked at a church in Willmar, Minnesota and Bethany Baptist in Roseville, Minnesota. She was then called to serve at Elim Baptist Church in Chicago, Illinois to be a children's worker. While in Chicago she met Robert Seline and they married in Chicago on June 14, 1952. After a time they welcomed two girls into their family through adoption, Janet and Kathy. She and Bob raised their daughters in Chicago and moved to the Twin Cities area in Minnesota in early 1980s where they remained, Bob passed away in 2007 and she remained in the Twin Cities until her passing on April 9, 2019.
