December 9, 1935 - March 18, 2019

Boyce, Allan Rex, age 83 of Blaine, MN, passed away March 18, 2019 in Brooklyn Park, MN of complications from Parkinson's Disease. Allan R. Boyce was born in Minneapolis, MN to Rex Vernon Boyce and Mae Adeline Carnes-Boyce on December 9, 1935. He married Maxine Joanne Engman on June 30, 1956 in Minneapolis, MN. He worked as a chef for Mr. Joe's Supper Club, then later at Pulaski's in Osseo, MN. He and Maxine served as King and Queen in their square dance club. He was the first baseman for the Minnesota state fast pitch softball champions, the Harris Tigers, and was on the Harris team that beat the "King's Court", the Eddie Feigner traveling All-Star team. Allan loved playing guitar in the family with his father, Rex, and his siblings, Gary, Lee, Wandy, Janny, and Jimmy. While a member of the St. Anthony Athletic Club, he was a two-time National Senior Men's Doubles Racquetball champion with Bob McNamara, and then with Bill Jukich. Allan served as a committee member of Boy Scout Troop 522. He was an avid gardener - his backyard tomatoes and green beans were legendary. But the loves of his life were his wife, Maxine, his family, and fishing - primarily on the St. Croix River. Preceded in death by wife, Maxine J. Boyce; parents, Rex V. Boyce and Mae A.
