Alonzo Juan Casa De Calvo (Lonnie) of Roseville, MN passed away peacefully Sunday morning, January 23rd, 2022, at the age 81 years. Alonzo was born November 11, 1940, in St. Paul, MN (during the famous Armistice Day Blizzard)

He battled cancer with the same strength, determination, and faith that he lived his life.
