



## Alpha V. Anderson

January 21, 1910 - May 25, 2020

Alpha V. Anderson was born January 21, 1910, the youngest of five children. As a young girl she came to know Jesus as her Savior and Lord through the influence of godly parents and her regular involvement in the activities of Bethany Covenant Church in Minneapolis. She attended South High School, graduating in 1928. The day before her graduation Alpha began working at Butler Brothers Company in Minneapolis, where she was employed for the next twelve years. During these years of employment she met her future husband, Herman Anderson. They dated for several years and were married on September 7, 1940, shortly after Herman graduated from North Park Theological Seminary. As a pastor's wife Alpha was involved in the ministries of the various congregations they served together over the next thirty five years.
