They met in Minneapolis, and their friendship continued long after my grandparents moved down to Chicagoland (where my family still resides to this day). I remember Alvin and his wife, Inge, would drive down to Chicago a couple of times a year to visit - I remember the breakfasts were very yummy, and I always looked forward to them.
