



Mr. Amin Kamal Gemei

July 24, 1941 - July 27, 2018

Amin Kamal Gemei, age 77 of St. Louis Park died on Friday July 27th, 2018 at home after a long battle with MSA- Multiple Systems Atrophy.

The son of Kamal and Olfat (Lofty) Gemei was born on July 24th, 1941 in Shuni Egypt.

Amin graduated from the University of Alexandria, Egypt in 1966 with a degree in Agricultural Engineering. He came to the United States in 1974. He went to the University of Minnesota to further his education. Amin worked at various companies as an Agricultural Engineer. In his retirement years he drove a school bus for the Edina and St. Louis Park school districts.

Amin married Patricia M. Stine on September 15, 1979 at her parents home in Faribault, Mn. In 1981 Amin became an official United States citizen.
