REMEMBRANCE I, or rather we, as I strongly believe Amy is in our presence, thank you all for your attendance. Her intelligence, sincerity, and graciousness forged instant friendships as those present here can attest to. Her very essence inspired confidence and blessed those who she came into contact with a certain... serendipity. She enabled friends and family alike to rise above their problems. She gave people hope and encouragement; something she sought to do in the grandest of scales. Amy made a positive difference in the lives of those people she touched, and in so doing, made the world a better place. Knowing that effect fulfilled Amy, bringing her immense joy. However, these very acts made for great irony because in the end, she had a difficult time doing these same things for herself. I do wish to address that. Many here today count themselves as Amy's friends and loved ones. Some may feel that we are here today because of some failure on our part. I must admit to feeling that way for a brief period of time. I would advise you, just as Amy would, that such thinking is not productive. It is wrong. The what-ifs?, I could have... I should have... these thoughts really do have no meaning. They are traps that lead to wallowing in self-pity. We should not dwell upon the past beyond that for which we can learn for ourselves. Amy and I would want that. Amy loved her family and

her childhood home in Missoula. She dearly wished that her beloved mother and father lived closer. She loved her sisters, Kay and Briana, always seeking to be there for them and to share in their lives. The world was always black and white for Amy, no shades of gray were allowed. This allowed her to singularly focus her energy and her love to those around her. To her family, that meant giving more than 100% each and every day. She did not falter. She loves you all. We should not remember Amy by the events of this last week. While she was victimized by the irrational actions that manifested a perfidious and insidious disease, she understood the truth that she has good friends. She knew the truth that her family cherishes her. Her rational self understood the truth that our daughters and I love her unconditionally and always will. We... should choose to remember these truths regarding Amy. I choose to remember Amy as that majestic force of Nature. She was a doting parent to her daughters. Her role of being mom was the most important thing to her. No task was too trivial, no concern left unaddressed. To our girls, no wound was not kissed, no fear not reassured by a strong hug, no desire was left unattended in the most immediate manner as befits a pair of impatient and stubborn girls. Amy often wondered where those traits came from. I wish to share a quality of Amy that few may have realized. Whenever Amy got involved in something that she really believed in or liked, she always worried that someone would beat her to the punch or steal her thunder. I attributed this to her western Montana roots by referring to this paranoia as her "claim-jumper mentality." Case in point: We were a young, newlywed couple in the

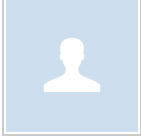
