Andrew (Andy) LeVoor, beloved son, brother, uncle, and friend passed away peacefully on December 21, 2024, at his group home in Wayzata.

Working was an important part of Andy's life, and he found fulfillment in his various employment opportunities at Jerry's Foods, Panera, and Home Goods. His employment was made possible and supported by Partnership Resources.
