



## Angela Marie Newcomb

Angela Marie Newcomb, known by most as Angie or Ang, passed away unexpectedly on October 9, 2024, at Regions Hospital in St. Paul, MN at the age of 37. Surrounded by her loved ones in her final moments, she left this world far too soon after a brave battle with a serious illness.

Unapologetically weird, playful, adventurous, and joyful, she had an infectious laugh and a zest for life. Angie was loving, compassionate, and eager to help others. A true free spirit, she lived outside the box and was always willing to try new things.

Her hobbies reflected her vibrant personality-she loved singing, writing, dancing awkwardly, cooking ethnic dishes, pranking people, practicing yoga, and watching cheesy Bollywood movies. A devoted family member, Angie cherished her time with loved ones. She was known as the fun aunt to her niece and nephews and always made time for family gatherings. Singing karaoke with her brothers was one of her favorite pastimes, bringing joy and laughter to the family.

Angie is survived by her mother, Linda Erlandson; her father, Jon Newcomb; and her four older brothers, James, David, Paul, and Jon. She also leaves behind many extended family members and friends who loved her dearly. In her final days, when asked what was most important to her, Angie simply stated, "family."
