Boosalis, Angeline "Angie" Morris (nee Handris) of Minneapolis, Minnesota and Chicago, Illinois, passed away peacefully on February 22, in Chicago, Illinois. Angie, one of seven children, was born in Duluth, Minnesota on April 15, 1921. She married Isadore Morris in 1941 in Minneapolis, where they owned Morris and Christie Foods, a specialty food market, 31st and Hennepin. In 1958, when Morris died unexpectedly, she successfully ran the business for 13 years with loyal support from her employees, customers, and friends.
