Ann Selenski, 80, died Monday evening in St. Louis Park. She was born at Maternity Hospital in Minneapolis on February 18, 1942. As a child, Annie lived with her family on a peninsula on Medicine Lake in Plymouth until she was eight, when her family moved to Golden Valley. She spent all her life in the Minneapolis metro area.

After graduating from Golden Valley High School, Annie took her first job with Harold's Clothier, where she learned the art of ribbon making. After attending the Minnesota School of Business, she found work utilizing her typing skills as a clerk with General Parts and Supply. Her love of children then led her to a long career at Hennepin County Medical Center as a Nurse's Aide in the maternity ward. She loved holding babies and through her attentiveness, saved the lives of several children when she noticed they had stopped breathing.

Annie maintained a strong faith in Jesus Christ as her savior and was a steady churchgoer. She was known for hugs that would warm your heart and fill your soul. She supported many ministries and was especially known for her book ministry, of which all the books were donated to Bibles for Missions.

Annie was very generous and loving to her siblings and their families. She was especially close with her nephew, Joe Cornelius, who she dearly enjoyed spending time with. Annie was also a loyal friend and lived for many years with her close friend, Brenda Littlewolf. She developed and maintained friendships with Brenda's daughters and grandchildren.

Annie was preceded in death by her parents Mary (Lohr) Selenski, from whom she inherited her compassion and kindness, and Eugene Selenski, from whom she inherited her smile and a wry sense of humor.
