She was a fan of John Wayne movies and an avid sports fan, cheering for the Twins and Vikings. In later years, she enjoyed traveling with her sisters on adventures from Florida to the Pacific Ocean. Anna Mae is survived by 4 children: Barbara Michel, Roger Mallory, Darlene (Gary) Hanson and Richard Mallory; 4 grandchildren: Robert Thomas (Christine) Michel, Marc (Stephanie) Michel, Paul Hanson and Andrea Fiske-Mallory; 4 great-grandchildren: Andrew (Hannah), Jacob, Aaron, and Raelynn.
