Gray, Anne L. passed away peacefully on April 16, 2023 at The Waters on 50th in southwest Minneapolis. Anne was born to Warren W. Gray and Borghild Vitek Gray on February 15, 1938 in Minneapolis. She is survived by her husband, George A. Jacobsen, whom she married in 2017, one sister, Mary Gray Brinkman, Mary's husband, Dale, and several nieces and a nephew. Anne graduated from Robbinsdale High School in 1956 where she had played the French horn in the school band. For a number of years, she also performed with the Robbinsdale City band. After high school, Anne enrolled at St. Olaf College and graduated in 1960 with majors in English and History. While on campus, she served as the senior class secretary, was a member of the Zeta Chi Omega Society, served on the Manitou Messenger student newspaper staff, was a member of the student national education association, and the Inter Society Board. Anne then went on to earn a Master of Arts degree from the University of Minnesota. For many years she was a teacher in the Robbinsdale School District and served as an elementary school librarian in several schools. Following St. Olaf, she married Dean David Weber, a fellow classmate at St. Olaf. Dean passed away in 2011. A few years after Dean's passing, she married George Jacobsen, a member of the St. Olaf Class of 1958. At the request of her husband, there will be no memorial service.
