After their marriage, Anne and Dennis raised their two boys in Terre Haute until a career advancement with Bemis Company prompted a move to Minneapolis in 1970 where they settled in Edina. Over the years, they enjoyed the companionship of several miniature schnauzers including their last one Soffi. Anne was an avid collector of antique dolls from France and Germany, as well as vintage Christmas and
