Anne Ziemer peacefully took her last breath and went to meet her Lord at sunrise on the morning of June 18, 2019. Born on September 10, 1925, Anne grew up in Minneapolis. She graduated from St. Margaret's Academy and went on to complete a degree in Home Economics at the University of Minnesota. On August 30, 1947 she married Bill Ziemer.
