Younger, Annie Dean (Meadows) went home to the Lord on Monday, Dec. 7, 2020. She died of complications of lung cancer at age 86. Annie treasured three things in her life on Earth: Her relationship with God, her late husband, Robert Younger, and her family. Supporting her children brought her much joy and satisfaction. She spent hours playing with her four children, including taking them to get penny candy and taking them shopping before family road trips. Annie was a gentle soul, but that didn't mean she would back down to anyone. She went to Huntington, a predominately white college, where she and her white girlfriends stuck together, even when color was an issue. She met her husband during her college years, bonding over their shared passion of music; she sang while he played the piano. They married in 1956 and lived in Fort Wayne, IN, before moving to Bloomington, MN in 1964. Annie worked at Northwest Airlines and made many friends during her fifteen years there. She was a founding member and actively involved at Christ Presbyterian Church, known to take the same aisle seat every Sunday. Annie's family is grateful for the strength, example and legacy she leaves for her children and grandchildren. She will be greatly missed by her four children (Cyndi, Carrie, Carol and Jimmy), 10 grandchildren, and 1 great grandchild.
