Roos, Arnold William Age 65, of Minneapolis, died Aug 4, 2022, of natural causes. His many relatives and friends were shocked by his sudden death. Born Nov 12, 1956, in Schenectady, NY, and later lived with his family in New Jersey, Iowa, Colorado, and North Dakota. Graduated from Jamestown (ND) College as valedictorian in 1978 with a history degree. He moved to the Twin Cities in 1992. He was happiest when on stage. Arnie was kind, hard-working, funny, entertaining, musical, well-read, and committed to his family and church. He loved to talk about books, music, pop culture, and politics. He was preceded in death by his parents, Arvin and Augusta Roos of Strasburg, ND. Survivors include three siblings, Sylvia (Randy) Ryan, Judith Carter, and Robert (Terry) Roos; three nieces, Suzanne Ryan, Andrea Carter, and Sally Carter; three nephews, Dylan Hicks, Christopher Ryan, and Matthew Ryan; and many cousins, great-nieces, and great-nephews.
