Arthur George Lowell (Art), passed away peacefully at NC Little Hospice on Saturday, February 8, 2025. He is survived by his loving wife of 52 years, Marcia, and his children, Kim and Jon (Jeni), along with his treasured grandchildren, Taylor (26), Dylan (24), Riley (21), Jordan (18), Olivia (18) and Miles (15).

Art, in good keeping with taking advantage of all opportunity that presented itself, graduated from the University of Minnesota with a Mechanical Engineering degree in the midst of the Korean War and his greatest love was working for the Naval Research Lab (diffusing nuclear bombs) but he also had pride in his 25+ year career at Control Data.

Perhaps because he was first generation Italian American, growing up in Northeast, Minneapolis in 1940s & 50s, Art was a hard worker, a problem solver, an innovator, and the kind of person who would literally give the shirt off his back for his fellow man. In addition to his mechanical engineering career, he also spent half of his life as a property owner, always treating his tenants as family, ensuring their needs were met whenever possible, always with the eye to leaving a legacy for his family.

First and foremost, family was the focus of Art's last 52 years, and his wisdom will be missed but his legacy will carry on through his grandchildren. As he

once said, "Bring on the bambinos" and so it shall be.
