After patiently waiting for the LORD's perfect timing, Arthur ("Handsome Art") William George Posingies peacefully entered into the joy of heaven on July 2, 2020, at age 90.

Arthur was born in 1929 to Michael and Lydia (Burmeister) Posingies and grew up on his family's farm in Edina, MN. He graduated from Minneapolis Southwest High School in 1949, where he was known for his singing. After business school, he worked as a journalist for the Construction Bulletin and Daily Construction News; co-owned a music production company; and worked in the grocery business, eventually owning two Country Boy markets. He later worked at B. Dalton booksellers, which fit well with his love of people and passion for Christian reading. Art was also active in his church in many capacities.

Arthur gave up driving and moved downtown Minneapolis in his 40's. He enjoyed walking the skyway system and riding public transit almost daily after retirement, even after his 90th birthday. His favorite destinations were Southdale, the MoA, Curran's, and downtown Walgreens. If you met Art, you probably have his calling card or a "\$1 million bill" with his picture on it.

Art often spoke of how much he was looking forward to heaven. "For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain" Philipians 1:21.

Arthur was preceded in death by his parents and brother Walter. He is survived by niece Linda (Kevin) and great-nephews Justin & Caleb.
