



## Betty Eisenstadt

March 11, 1923 - November 21, 2020

On Saturday, November 21, 2020, Betty Silver Eisenstadt, age 97, passed away in her home after a long illness. She was born in Beulah, ND on March 11, 1923. She later moved with her family to Bismark where she went to high school and honed her secretarial skills, winning the title of fastest typist and shorthand taker in North Dakota.
