Mattheis, Beverly (Tjosvold) passed away quietly on the morning of April 12, 2024, in Arden Hills, Minnesota, at the age of 95. Beverly was born in Montevideo, Minnesota on August 15, 1928, to Anna (Mooney) and Conrad Tjosvold. She was a loving and devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and aunt, and will be greatly missed by all who knew her. Beverly was a dedicated and active member of the Lutheran Church and performed volunteer services both to her churches and to the communities in which she lived. She was a lifelong Twins, Vikings, and Gophers fan, and rarely missed a televised Twins game in the later years of her life. Beverly was a gracious hostess with a warm smile, and was proud of her homes, husband, children, and grandchildren, and will be long remembered for her doughnuts, cookies, bars, and lefse by those
