A graduate of Parkersburg HS, Bill joined the USAF and become a Radar Operator. There, his talent for drawing was discovered and switched to drafting and poster making. While stationed in Minnesota, he met his bride of 65 years, and settled in Minnesota after his term. With the combined talents of artistic drawing and mechanical know-how, Bill had a successful career as a mechanical and patent draftsman. Bill's work can be found on thousands of patents filed in the US Patent Office, and was proud of his work on "The Electric Brain" early computers. The last of the pen and ink draftsmen, he was still called on by patent attorneys to do work into his 86th year. Bill was a wonderful artist whose works were primarily landscapes and churches. His drawings documenting dozens churches of Minnesota are works of historical significance. Bill loved to sing; performing with the Minnetonka Choral Society he toured Europe. He sang in church Choir and competed in numerous international competitions with the Minneapolis Commodores Barbershop Chorus. Bill will best be remembered as a loving Father, Husband and Grandfather who was happiest when with his family.
