age 33 of Saint Paul MN, passed away unexpectedly on Friday July 3rd, 2020.

Brandon was an extrovert with a great sense of humor and a huge heart. He was everyone's best friend. He was a loyal friend and a loving son, brother, uncle, nephew, cousin and grandson who went out of his way to make others feel important. He served in the United States Marine Corp Reserves and deployed to Iraq and Afghanistan in support of Operation Iraqi freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom. In Iraq, he was part of Task Force MP and conducted convoy security. In Afghanistan, he trained and mentored the Afghan National Police as part of NATO Training Mission Afghanistan. He obtained the rank of Sergeant and was honorably discharged after 8 years of service. Being a Marine was a huge accomplishment that he was proud of. Brandon was a man driven by his goals and discipline and had a genuine care and concern for everyone he met. Body building, nutrition, and self-education and growth were his passions. He diligently worked to keep people safe at Riverside Plaza in Minneapolis MN, where he headed up security, for 14 years, when not deployed, and protecting those he loved. He was compassionate, kind, selfless, funny, and brave and is loved and deeply missed by everyone who knew him. Brandon loved the Lord Jesus Christ with all his heart and soul and is now finally free and at peace with his Savior. Brandon is preceded in death by Grandmother Theresa M Schweim and

Grandfather Jerome K Schweim Sr.
