Brenda Stusse, 72, a long-time resident of Crystal, MN, passed away peacefully on March 16, 2024. She spent the last four months of her life living at the Villas of Robbinsdale Care Center.

Brenda Ann Johnson was born on August 20, 1951, in Mankato to Marvin (dec.) and Mildred Johnson. The following year the family moved to southern California where her next three siblings were born. The family enjoyed their time in California spending the weeknights having bar-b-q's with neighbors and the weekends exploring the area and visiting places like Disneyland. The Johnson family moved back to Minnesota when Brenda was twelve years old. They resided on a cattle farm in Glenwood where the youngest of the siblings was born. She played volleyball and softball, taught Sunday school, and worked part-time as a server at Pauline's and Baker's Square. She worked at National for over 20 years and had many good friends at the company and also at the Crystal VFW.

When her kids had their own families, Brenda was always there helping and

sharing her love. She was a very generous person and cherished her five grandkids. She also loved her stepdaughter, Renee, and her family. Brenda enjoyed traveling and spending any time she could with her two sisters and mom. They never let a birthday go by without celebrating one another. Brenda also had many close friends, including Robbin and Jeri, who were with her in the end.

Brenda will forever be remembered for her faith in Jesus Christ, her unyielding commitment to what she believed was right and good, her family and friends, her smile, her no-nonsense attitude, and the way in which she always looked out for everyone else - no matter who they were.
