Brian Brady, age 78, died on December 28, 2023, at the U of MN Medical Center in Minneapolis. Brian was born on August 1, 1945, to Joseph & Genevieve Brady. He grew up in SE Minneapolis and attended Tuttle Elementary School, Marshall High School Class of 1963. Brian attended the University of Minnesota where he met Kathy and received a Bachelor of Electrical Engineering degree from the University of Minnesota in 1967 and an MBA in 1989 from Katz School of the University of St. Thomas.

Brian & Kathy were married on April 27, 1968. They have three amazing children, John, Colleen and Patrick Brady and 4 grandchildren Colin, Gavin, Fiona & Penelope.

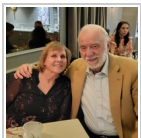
