Bruce Fred Boje was born April 27, 1948. His parents were Arnie and Ilene (Snyder) Boje of Waseca, MN. Bruce graduated from Waseca High School in 1966 where he was class valedictorian. He went on to the University of Minnesota where he received a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering. Bruce served in the Army from 1970 to 1972 with the rank of E4. He was awarded a National Defense Service medal for sharpshooting. He was stationed in Germany. Bruce played clarinet in the army band. Once back stateside he worked as a traffic consultant at various Engineering companies in the twin cities. He ended his career at Westwood Professional Services in Eden Prairie as a traffic consultant. His coworkers relied on his knowledge of Microsoft Excel; and Bruce was known to solve complex math problems in his head. He retired from Westwood in 2016. Bruce married Joyce (Henke) in March of 1976. Bruce and Joyce have two children, Ian and Kyle (Gayle). Bruce lived in Chanhassen, MN. Bruce's hobbies included bridge, bowling, biking, pickle ball and sudoku. Bruce is survived by his brother, Cory (Susan) Boje of Waseca, and sister, Melodie (Tony) Cuate of McAllen, TX.
