Calvin "Cal" Engelstad, died 2/11/2019 at the age of 91. He was preceded in death by his parents, Alfred and Emma Engelstad. He enjoyed playing golf until he was 85, and was an avid reader of the newspaper and books. He and Nola have been members of Westwood Lutheran Church in St. Louis Park since 1953, and Cal is a past President and Treasurer of the Congregation.
