



Carl "Chuck" William Edborg, Jr.

July 4, 1924 - April 24, 2014

Carl ("Chuck") Edborg was born on July 4, 1924, and died at the Lake Ridge Health Care Center, Roseville, on April 24, 2014. Born in Chicago, Chuck was later a resident of St. Paul, where he graduated from Murray High School in 1942.

His parents, Emma and Carl Edborg, Roseville, and a brother, Ralph ("Bud") Edborg, St. Paul, preceded him in death. A sister, Margaret Elizabeth Morgan, Roseville, and several nieces, nephews, and cousins survive him.

Chuck was a staff member of the University of Minnesota College of Veterinary Medicine, St. Paul, for 26 years. As a veteran of World War II, Chuck served for 14 months as a Staff Sergeant in the United States Army's Signal Corps in the Philippine Islands. His service awards include the American Theater Service Metal, the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Metal, and the Philippine Liberation Metal.
