She loved to play golf and was the president of the Whitefish Golf League in the 90s. Her favorite activity was being in the church choir. At 3 she started singing for

church events and retired at the age of 83 as an alto at Lord of Life Lutheran in Maple Grove. 80 years of singing the message of Christ as a dedicated choir member. She had the opportunity to travel around the world visiting China, Japan, Australia, most European countries, Norway, Sweden, Alaska, Hawaii, and most states in the USA. In 1984 they purchased a lake home near Nisswa, MN and she loved to spend all summer at the lake and visiting with friends. Then in her later years she was a proud grandmother and great grandmother and had the opportunity to share her love with her family in spite of physical issues that finally took her life.
