Carol Anne Ledig-Volk, age 71, of Eden Prairie, Minnesota, passed away unexpectedly on September 20, 2025, while vacationing at Lake Vermilion. Born on June 4, 1954, in Newark, New Jersey, Carol was the daughter of the late Richard Ledig Jr. and Ruthmary Fitzgerald Ledig. She grew up in Newark and graduated from Vailsburg High School in 1972. In 1975 she earned two simultaneous degrees—an Associate of Science from Union College and an RN Diploma from Muhlenberg Hospital School of Nursing—preparing her for a lifelong career in nursing. She devoted her professional life to caring for patients with compassion and dedication.

On December 1, 1990, Carol married Dr. Randall "Randy" Volk in Princeton, New Jersey. Together they made their home in Manahawkin, New Jersey, where they spent many years before relocating to Eden Prairie, Minnesota, in 2012 when Randy became head plastic surgeon at Sono Bello in Edina. Carol and Randy built a life filled with love, mutual support, and treasured memories.
