Bob and Carol enjoyed 25+ years with a second family home on Lake Minnetonka where the family enjoyed water activities, long weekends and lounging on the deck. She was a proud mother and grandmother who always had a story to share about "the kids" and was always there to help and support when needed. Carol loved to entertain, hosting a variety of gatherings that ranged from gourmet meals to simple coffee parties with the neighbors. She had a passion for people and gatherings. Carol was a caring person deeply loved by family and friends, including her snowmobile buddies at Breezy Point and her coffee group at the Valley West McDonald's in Bloomington.
