Carolyn Audrey Krumm was born December 22, 1931 in Mcleod County to Philip and Marie (Weber) Krumm. She attended elementary school near New Auburn, Mn and Biscay, Mn. She was confirmed at First Lutheran in Glencoe, MN in 1945 and attended Lutheran school and high school in Glencoe as well. She married Maynard Templin October 3, 1948. This marriage was blessed with two daughters, Betty Jean and Debra Lynn. They resided in rural Glencoe. Maynard died in 1955 and Carolyn moved her family to town and lived on DeSoto Ave. On April 12, 1957 Carolyn married LeRoy Majeski. This marriage was blessed with two more daughters, Jan Marie and Peggy Lee.

In 1962 the family moved to Hutchinson. During her long working career, Carolyn was employed at Carol's Fairway in Glencoe, Herb's Fairway, Riverside Cafe, J.C.Penneys, First National Bank, and Stevenson's Clothing-all in Hutchinson. In 1980 Lee's employment took her to Texas where she was employed at Target. They returned to Mn in 1990 where she continued to work at Target until age 82, a total of 33 years.

She enjoyed garage sales, cooking, baking, planting flowers and spending time with family and friends. She reconnected with relatives in Germany and took several trips to visit them, accompanied by different family members. She especially loved photos of her family and filled the dining room and bedroom walls with them. She had a special interest in the family history and geneology

and recruited her daughter, Debra, to help her compile four family books, the Weber family, the Krumm family, the Templin family and the Majeski family. A true labor of love.

Carolyn passed away at home at the age of 94 years.
