She was an excellent student in school and upon HS graduation she entered the Pharmacy School at U WY.

After getting her BS Pharm in 1958, she accepted a pharmacy position at St. Vincent Hospital in Los Angeles. Several years later she was an alto in the William Hall Chorale, and her future husband was there also-and noticed her. She loved solving puzzles of all sort.

There is a descriptive term that has fit Carolyn, from the Scandinavian Vikings; it is a Shield Maiden, who when called upon by circumstances, was a fierce warrior. Carolyn has been a Shield Maiden.

She is predeceased by her parents, her brothers H. LeRoy and Dennis.
