Chad Bernt Sluiter, 50, of Bloomington, MN, passed away unexpectedly, on February 2, 2019 at his residence. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 am Saturday, February 9, 2019 at Evergreen Community Church, Bloomington, MN. Visitation will be one hour prior to the Service the same day and location. 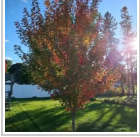
