Also during that time, Chuck began his career with Twin City Federal Savings & Loan. He started as a Teller in the downtown Minneapolis office. Over the next 25 years he progressed to hold positions from Loan Officer to Branch Manager to Vice President. He managed 7 different locations (3 at once!) and

opened 4 new offices in Eden Prairie, North Town, Dinkytown and University.

Chuck enjoyed hunting, fishing, snowmobiling, and traveling with his wife. Most of all, he enjoyed spending time with family and friends. He was best known for his "Dad jokes" and wonderful smile.
