



## Charles Mastel, SR

January 22, 1949 - February 15, 2022

Mastel, Charles Joseph "Chuck" Age 73, passed away February 15, 2022. Born in St. Paul on January 22, 1949, Chuck graduated from St Thomas Academy in 1967 and went on to study at the University of Minnesota. Chuck's passion for playing the odds led him to pursue a lifelong career as a commodities broker. He established and managed his company, Mastel Grain at the Grain Exchange in downtown Minneapolis loving every minute spent in the high pressure "pit".
