Ravine, Charles S. "Charley" of Saint Paul, MN passed away peacefully Monday, November 15, 2021 with his love, Christie Hammes, at his side. He was 74. He was the youngest child of William and Marcella Ravine, who preceded him in death, and is survived by his brothers Allen G Ravine and his wife Fran Ravine of Torrance, California and Harris Ravine of Lone Tree, Colorado, and his children Vija Miller and Mary Hammes both of Minneapolis, and Michelle Ferreira of Columbia Heights, MN. A long time resident of the Twin Cities, he graduated from Minneapolis Washburn (1965), the University of Minnesota with a B.A (1969), and the University of Minnesota Law School with a Juris Doctor (1973). Following Law School, Charley began his career of public service which over the remainder of his career focused on providing legal assistance to nonprofit organizations working to meet community needs - especially the needs of underserved -communities - in the areas of social service, health, education, arts and culture, and the environment, among many others. For more than thirty years, Charley headed up legal services at MAP for Nonprofits, a nonprofit consulting group based in Saint Paul, until "semi-retiring" and continuing to serve small organizations through his own consulting nonprofit. Those who were fortunate to have known him, will miss the kind, gentle and caring person who always had time to listen. His children recall particularly his tender guidance and consistent support.
