Sunder, Charles A. Age 78, died unexpectedly in his Minneapolis home on Tuesday, Aug. 4, of an apparent heart attack. Chuck was born on Dec. 3, 1936, in Jordan, MN, to Alois and Regina Sunder. He graduated from Jordan High School in 1954 and enlisted in the USAF.
