Woehrle, Charles Boyd Age 98, of St. Paul, MN. Born in Nashua, Iowa on September 28, 1916, died on March 25, 2015 at the Episcopal Church Home. He attended the University of Minnesota. He will be remembered for his steadfast Christian faith, his love and devotion to friends and family, his grace and kindness, and ability to tell a great story.
