Chester graduated from Taylor High School in 1944. He was drafted into the Army during WWII and trained at Fort Hood, TX. When the war ended Chester was serving on the island of Saipan After her returned home, he worked on his parents farm for a year. He then graduated from North Central Bible College in 1950 and took a job at Eaton Corp as a machine operator for 32 years.
